The California Adult Education Canvas Commons is a dedicated space within the larger Canvas Commons where California adult educators can access OTAN EL Civics resources and other shared resources on the Canvas LMS. This Canvas resource is meant to support COAAP 1.6 Banking, which includes the following Tasks:

- Task 1: Inquire at a Bank
- Task 2: Make a Budget
- Task 3: Find and Compare Information on Banking Institutions

These materials can be used to teach EL Civics content to English language learners as part of the 30 hours of instruction required in California before administering an EL Civics COAAP assessment. These materials, including videos, discussions, glossaries, helpful links, and other practice materials, are designed to be used as-is or can be adapted or modified for classroom usage. Many of the activities are interactive and are designed to provide listening, speaking, reading, and writing practice.
